

Charlie, the son of Verne Charles and Aimee Bell

(McEnelly) Nye, was born March 27, 1921, in Fertile. He graduated from Fertile High School in 1939. He enlisted in the United States Navy in June of 1942, where he served in World War II.

He married Florence V. Larson on July 28, 1945.

Charlie worked as a butter maker in the Fertile and Clear Lake creameries, a mechanic at the Chevrolet dealer in Fertile, owned grocery stores in Fertile and Hanlontown, and retired in 1983 from the Iowa DOT.

After the war, Charlie played baseball in the borderline baseball league for 12 years and after retiring he played hockey with the Mason City Novice Hockey League until he was 80 years old.

Charlie was involved in a number of community activities including Lions Club, summer youth baseball, fire department, and town government to name a few. He was instrumental in sponsoring and building the town's first lighted baseball field. Charlie was fortunate to attend an Honor Flight trip to Washington, DC, in April 2010 which he thoroughly enjoyed.

He is survived by sons, Roger (Johanna) Nye of Graham, WA, Jerry Nye of Fertile and Brian (Cynthia) Nye of Longmont, CO; niece, Mary Ann Stram of Bloomington, MN, and her family He was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Florence in 2012; brother, Charles Norman Nye; and sister, Doris (in infancy).

### Bob Kuhn's story continues......

The first year in North Dakota one morning it rained a little so we could not thrash right away and I told the boss that I needed a haircut, he said "Take my Ford and go to Baker, a town about 10 miles away, about the size of Fertile. I stopped at a filling station to ask where the barber shop was. He told me how to get there and that the barber was deaf and dumb. I went in the shop and motioned that I wanted a haircut. He was about half done cutting my hair when the station man walked in and asked how soon the barber could go and golf with him. The barber said "Just as soon as I finish cutting this deaf and dumb guy's hair." We all had a laugh at that. Even tho the joke was on me I still laugh every time I think of it. I bet those men pull that on a lot of people.

A man asked me to help him overhaul Model-T motors. I didn't know anything about them, but he told me to take them apart and clean them and he would replace the worn parts and put them back together. We got all the motors done late in March and decided to go to Omaha for a few days.

While there we stayed in a hotel and one evening we were sitting in the lobby, a man walked past a little ways and came back and asked where we were from. We told him and he said he needed help the first of April in Fertile, lowa. We told him we would think it over. He said "You be in Fertile the first of April and you'll have a job."

We decided to go to Fertile, so on the 31<sup>st</sup> of March we started out early in the morning and got to LeMars for breakfast. They said, "eggs and style," and then it dawned on us that it was Easter.

We were going again and made good time, then something needed to be fixed on the Model -T so we had it fixed at a garage. We drove about 40 miles and my buddy Charley Johnson saw a wrench between the fender and the hood of the car so we decided that fellow that left it there might need it before we got back, so we went back there and gave it to him. He was delighted to get it back.

We made good time until we got to Sanderson's hill west of Fertile and couldn't make it up the hill going forward, so we backed down, turned around and backed up the hill and made it into Fertile and asked a fellow where the hotel was. He told us that we had to go to Hanlontown as they were a railroad town. We later found out that young fellow was Mort Haugen.

We got food and lodging at the hotel and we learned that the grading company couldn't come from Alma because of the soft roads.

We were eating breakfast the next morning and a man opened the door and asked if anyone would like a job. Charley asked what the job was and he said "Blacksmith, right behind the bank."

A little later another man asked the same, and I asked "What is your trade?" He said "Carpentry right behind the bank. Both of their names were Brattrud.

We worked for them for 8 days as the grading outfit was on the way over and would arrive on Wednesday and would camp in the field just west of the Free Church and cemetery.

We stood by the fence as they went by and Charley saw a 3 mule team go by. He said "If I drive the dump wagon that's the team I'd like to drive."

The next team stopped to rest and when the driver wanted to start they balked and I said "I would like to drive that team and they wouldn't balk." We didn't know the boss was standing behind us so those were the teams we got. We helped put up the bunk houses, the kitchen and the feed bunks for the horses and the tent over the feed bunks.

We started at the county live west of Fertile and when we got about half way we moved across south of the mill and a little west. At that time Highway 9 came down through town and back north. Highway 9 was put through in the early 40's where it is now.

We finished the job up to where Highway 9 is now and then moved to Lake Mills and graded the road from Scarville, and finished the Fall of 1923. We moved to Buffalo Center to grade the road from there to Rake the next spring. TO BE CONTINUED




