

COOK'S CORNER PIZZA SPAGHETTI

¾ lb. Thin spaghetti, cooked and drained

2 eggs, beaten

34 c. milk

1 (32 oz.) jar spaghetti sauce

1 lb. uncooked hamburger

Sliced pepperoni

2 c. Shredded Mozzarella cheese

1 c. shredded Cheddar cheese

Mix eggs and milk; toss with spaghetti. Spread in Pam-sprayed 9x18 inch pan, or two smaller ones. Top with spaghetti sauce. Sprinkle uncooked hamburger in pinch —size pieces over top of sauce. Press down into sauce a little. Arrange sliced pepperoni in rows over this. Top with cheeses. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes or until bubbly and hamburger is done. Let stand 5 minutes. Cut in squares.

NOTE: May be frozen for baking at a later time

EASY CINNAMON ROLLS

2 loaves frozen bread

1 lg. pkg. vanilla pudding (not instant)

½ cup butter or oleo

½ tsp. Cinnamon

1 c. brown sugar

2 T. milk

Let dough thaw, but not rise. Break 1 loaf in a greased 9 x 13 inch pan. Don't be fussy. Combine other ingredients until melted on stove; pour over dough. Break other loaf and put it over all. Let rise. Bake at 350 – 375 degrees for ½ hour.




