19" pie crust 1 Tsp. butter 1 cup brown sugar, firmly packed 1 tsp. vanilla ½ cup flour 4 egg yolks beaten 1/8 tsp salt 4 egg whites 3 cups milk 1/3 cup sugar Beat egg yolks and put in pan. Add ½ cup milk and cook until hot. Mix together sugar, salt and flour. Add to milk and egg mixture. Cook until thick, stirring constantly. Remove from stove. Add vanilla and butter. Pour into pie shell. Beat egg whites until stiff. Gradually add 1/3 cup sugar; beat until stiff. Put on top of pie, sealing edges. Bake at 350 degrees until brown.






When the operator challenges the line by the use of "Are you waiting?" Are you through?" and you make no reply and she disconnects you, who is to blame for getting cut off?


